



Luxemburgish hospitality entrepreneur Camille Leweck receives the European Hospitality Foundation award



Luxembourg, 24 April 2015 –Camille Leweck, owner of the Sporthotel Leweck, became today the new laureate of the European Hospitality Foundation (EHF) award, a prize granted by the European hospitality industry for Mr. Leweck’s visionary contribution to the hotel and restaurant industry in Luxembourg.

The European Hospitality Foundation award is delivered twice a year to a personality who has contributed, in a remarkable manner, and for a significant number of years to the activities of the hospitality industry. The EHF award was designed by Miquel Planas, famous artist and chairman of the Sculpture Department of Fine Arts of the Fine Arts Faculty of Barcelona. The next EHF award ceremony will take place on 6 November 2015 in The Hague.
