Costakis Loizou - Curriculum Vitae



Costakis Loizou was born in Limassol. After his graduation from the American College in Athens, he studied Economics and Business Administration in London and Geneva. Upon his return to Cyprus, he worked with his father Louis Loizou, acknowledged as “the father of Cyprus Tourism”, in the family run Louis Tourist Agency. In 1971, he took over the business as Chairman and Managing Director. Today he is the Executive Chairman of Louis Group, the leading tourism organization in the Eastern Mediterranean with activities in travel, tourism, hotels, cruising and catering.

Costakis Loizou has attended many international tourism and economic conferences and fora. He has written several articles on tourism and as a leading public figure in Cyprus he has chaired or served on the boards of notable governmental, semi-governmental and professional organizations and associations.

Since 1989, Costakis Loizou is the Honorary Consul General of Hungary in Cyprus. The government of Hungary honoured him with the recognition of the “Commander’s Cross of the Order of Merit” as well as with the medal “PRO AUXILIO CIVIUM HUNGARORUM”. He has also been honoured by Poland with the “Cavalier’s Cross of the Order of Merit”. In 2005 he received the International Society of Hospitality Consultants “Pioneer Award” for his contribution to European tourism.
